The Vision

Saint Nicholas School wanted its tired, uninspiring EYFS playground transformed with colour and theme, with zones linking to the seven areas of EYFS learning and equipment built to need minimum maintenance.



Why Caloo?

- Design built around EYFS learning, not just play
- Low-maintenance aluminium Quali-Cité equipment with HPL colour panels
- One cohesive themed environment, not a mix of unrelated kit
- Delivered to a fixed deadline, ready for the new term



The Solution

A castle-themed Four Tower Castle Multiplay unit anchors the space, alongside a horse and carriage play unit, a Roman Bridge, an amphitheatre performance area, a musical sensory zone and an imaginative shop fronts zone, all set on new artificial grass and wet pour surfacing.



The Impact

The transformation gave the school's youngest pupils a colourful, themed EYFS space built around exploration, supporting creativity, communication and motor skill development, delivered and ready before children returned for the new term.
