The Vision

Weston Turville Parish Council wanted to refresh its play area, replacing worn equipment with something more accessible and inclusive, genuinely serving toddlers and wheelchair users alongside older children.



Why Caloo?

- A genuinely accessible play unit for toddlers and wheelchair users together
- Proper groundworks before resurfacing, not surfacing laid over an unprepared base
- A fully managed installation from fencing through to inspection



The Solution

A Quali-Cité Accessible Multiplay unit with Castle Playhouse anchors the refresh, alongside a Quali-Cité RE 210 horse springer, a Quali-Cité RE 333 bee springer, and a steel-framed Quali-Cité swing, all connected by extended wetpour safety surfacing.



The Impact

The play area now gives toddlers and wheelchair users genuine access to play alongside everyone else, backed by safer, freshly prepared wet pour surfacing.
